OTEX ozone disinfection: the natural solution to mould removal

JLA's portable OTEX room sanitisers use the natural disinfecting power of ozone to safely remove the bacteria that causes harmful mould.

In recent independent tests, these sanitisers were proven to reduce surface mould spores by 92.4% and air mould spores by 68%.

What's more, our room sanitisers meet the strict standards of the EU Biocidal Products Regulation and GB Biocidal Product Regulation framework, making us one of the UK's only suppliers able to prove that our sanitisers reduce mould.

OTEX room sanitiser: key features

- Fully automatic system including ozone generation and destruct.
- Pre-programmed process cycles for ease of use and reduced operator error.
- Meets EN 17272 standards for distribution and disinfection efficacy against a wide range of micro-organisms.
- Safe Entry System (SES) allows accurate measurement of the ozone generation levels to verify disinfection, together with ambient ozone levels to confirm that the sealed and unoccupied room is safe to enter. Data is stored on an integral SD card for ease of access and audit proof of process.
- Full risk assessment created in line with BPR requirements, plus training logs and commissioning certificates.
- Optional air sampling with analysis and photos of before and after samples. Surface disinfection will also be carried out. Full report to be produced with all data for site included. All analysis carried out by an independent microbiological laboratory.
- Deodorises the room and removes odours leaving the fresh, clean smell of ozone.


The EU Biocidal Products Regulation (528/2012) and GB BPR (January 2021) cover any biocide marketed in Europe and Great Britain. Both regulations are designed to guarantee a high level of protection for humans, animals and the environment by ensuring recognised standards are met. The regulation is particularly important where ozone products are being considered, in that anyone placing an ozone generator on the market claiming a biocidal application within the EU or GB must have their product authorised in line with the BPR.

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"As is the case for any product placed on the market which claims disinfection, both JLA's OTEX ozone laundry system and room sanitiser machines are subject to the Biocidal Products Regulation (BPR). Improving housing conditions

Michael Gove introduced Awaab's Law in February 2023 – an amendment to the Social Housing Regulation Bill. These new regulations mean that social landlords are fully accountable for the service their residents receive, and must investigate and fix health hazards including damp and mould within fixed timescales.

Following the tragic death of Awaab Ishak in December 2020 the government have committed to improving the quality of social housing. Landlords will now be fully accountable for the service they provide to their residents, resulting in a crackdown on damp and mould under new legislation in memory of Awaab.

On the back of this, on 9th February 2023, Michael Gove announced the introduction of 'Awaab's Law'.



What is mould?

Mould grows best in damp and poorly ventilated conditions. It reproduces by making spores which are invisible to the naked eye but are present in the air around us. Mould can grow quickly on surfaces where dampness persists, or water has formed.

What does the Law mean for housing associations?

Housing associations must investigate and fix serious problems within strict time limits.

Amendments to the Social Housing (Regulation) Bill now gives new powers to The Housing Ombudsman to help landlords improve their performance.

Housing associations must provide evidence to the Housing Regulator that they have systems in place to deal with damp and mould reports.

What does the Law mean for residents?

Greater reassurance that their own home is safe, decent and warm.

The new rules will form part of the residents agreement, so residents can hold landlords to account by law if they fail to provide a decent home.

A healthier home as landlords are required to fix reported health hazards within specified time frames.

The Housing Health and Safety Rating System (HHSRS)

According to the principles of The Housing Health and Safety Rating System (HHSRS), any dwelling (a flat, house, self-contained flat, bed-sit or room in a hostel or similar residential building) should provide a safe and healthy environment for someone to live in.

The HHSRS places a legal duty on landlords to assess and regularly review the condition of their properties to ensure they are safe and free from hazards.
